

Introduction

- ◆ There are many standards for Carbon dioxide (CO2) accounting and trading.
- Standard are regulations that directly limits CO2 emissions from emitters.
- ◆ Standards are important in the verification of the amount of CO2 emitted.
- ◆ Three main standards are discussed.

Gold Standard was established in 2003 by WWF and other international NGOs to ensure projects that reduced carbon emissions featured the highest levels of environmental integrity and also contributed to sustainable development.




Fig.2 Strategy for the implementation of Gold Standard





The VCS Program allows certified projects to turn their greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reductions and removals into tradable carbon credits. VCS projects include dozens of technologies and measures which result in GHG emission reductions and removals.




Fig.3 Strategy for the implementation of Verified Carbon Standard

630 **Nearly** Million **1700 Projects Tonnes of** CO₂e certified reduction



The Clean Development Mechanism (CDM), defined in Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol, allows a country with an emission-reduction commitment to implement an emissionreduction project in developing countries.




Fig.4 Strategy for the implementation of Clean Development Mechanism
